Proposed change of age range at Haversham Village School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the 'Making prescribed alterations to maintained schools – Statutory guidance for proposers and decision makers, April 2016', that Milton Keynes Council, Saxon Court, 502 Avebury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes, MK9 3HS intends to make a prescribed alteration to Haversham Village School (Community school), The Crescent, Haversham, Milton Keynes, MK19 7AN from 1 September 2018.

Haversham Village School is currently an infant school with provision for children aged 4 to 7. The capacity of the school is 75. Milton Keynes Council intends to change the age range of the school. The proposed change will make provision for 25 places in Year 3 from September 2018 onwards. Every September thereafter, 25 pupils will remain at the school so that the school will eventually accommodate Year 3, 4, 5 and 6. Therefore by September 2021 the school will have a total of 175 places available over the seven year groups.
